

The Cambridge Checkpoint Examinations were conducted in November/ December and its result was published on 13th January 2014.

Cambridge programmes and qualifications have a proven reputation for being an excellent preparation for university, employment and life. These tests are used to monitor learners' readiness for the next stage of education and helps schools make strategic decisions.

The seventh batch of CNIS wrote this diagnostic checkpoint test in the month of October 2013 and came out with flying colors, making the school proud of its teaching approach and faith in Cambridge. Scores on the Cambridge Checkpoint scale are from 0.0 (the lowest level of ability) to 6.0 (the highest level of ability).

Time Table

With effect from 1st of January 2014 the time table was changed from 8 periods a day to 7 periods, so that each period gets 45 minutes. This was the long term requests of teachers; there would be only 35 periods a week instead of 40.

CCTV Cameras

From the 1st of January in all the class rooms and open areas CCTV cameras were installed to closely monitor the activities within the school.

RESULTS OF CAMBRIDGE CHECKPOINT EXAMINATIONS

This year 38% of the CNItes appearing in the exam, scored above the average score of 3.2 for the total entry for Cambridge Checkpoint English. The highest scoreres in our school are: Aparna Nair (4.2), Meenakshi Anil (4.5), M Arham Ibrahim Rasheed (4.4), Swetha Arun (4.4) and Soorya Narayan Prem Kishore (4.2).

The average score for Cambridge Checkpoint Mathematics exam is 5.0 and 68% of the CNItes appearing in the exam scored above this value; and 10 of our students scored the full 6.0 marks: They are Adheip M Nair, Aparna Nair, Arya S Vijay, Ganapathy K, Haider Abdul Jaleel, Meenakshi Anil, Sarang Rakesh, Shiva AnilKumar, Abel Mathew Vinod Panicker and Soorya Narayan Prem Kishore.

In Science 4 of our students scored the maximum mark of 6.0; they are Aparna Nair, Sarang Rakesh, Arham Rasheed, and Soorya Narayan Prem Kishore. And 11 of our students scored above 5.5 score. The international average of Checkpoint exams for science is 4.8; 68% of our students scored above this value.

SMS Alert System

In order to keep in touch with parents and to give them timely information regarding activities in the school the SMS Alert System was introduced on 10th of January 2014.

Cambridge Examinations

Checkpoint Exams for Grade VIII started on 21st October 2013, it went on till the end of November 2013. 37 students of our school appeared for this exam.

From 23.10.2013 the IGCSE exams conducted by Cambridge also started. 22 Students of our school, and one private students were appearing for the exam for O Level exam, and 11 Students for AS level, and 7 students for A level exams.

Solar Energy

Solar electricity generation system students of Gr.IX and XI visted on 1.11.2013 the home of Dr. RVG Menon. He explained in detail the nonconventional energy systems, and demonstrated to the students how the solar system works in his house, and how he saves money and energy through that.

8/11/2013 Assembly was held and during the assembly Award to Hindu Young Talent Quiz was announced.

Educational Tour

Students of IX and XI (32 students) as part of the annual educational tour went to Kanthari International Institute in Vellayani, to study the trends in modern technology systems.

International Partnership with Cermany



As part of the partnership with Hohenstaufen School, Kaiserslautern, in Germany our students visited Germany in June 2013. The delegation from the German school came arrived here on 12th January 2014 for the return visit. They were here till the 25th of January. They were accorded a warm reception in the school on the 13th morning at a special Reception Assembly, which was followed by a Reception Lunch at Windsor Rajadhani Hotel, Kaudiar. On the first day itself the German delegation presented their

studies on the impact of IT in their society.

During their stay here they visited all the important places at Trivandrum, including VSSC. Technopark, Rajiv Gandhi Biotechnology Centre, Indian Institute of Space Science at Valiamala, Goethe Centre, etc. We took a day out to visit Cochin; the travel was in train and bus, which gave them an railway insight into the system and transportation. Next day we visited Alleppey and had a ride in the houseboat along the Vembanad Lake.

On 19th January we visited the Chief Minister Oommen Chandy at Cliff House and had a discussion about various issues of our State. We visited also the Water Resource Minister P.J. Joseph. Mayor of Trivandrum City came to our school on 23rd January and had an hour long discussion with the visiting German Students.






















International Partnership with France








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
