Curriculum

CNIS follows the Cambridge international curriculum that sets a global standard for education, and is recognized by universities and employers worldwide. The curriculum is flexible and allows the school to add relevant regional/local content. CNIS adds it in Grades I-VII however, from Grade VIII onwards, it is purely as suggested by the Cambridge International Curriculum.

The education system in CNIS spans across four sections:

- ◆ Kindergarten
- ◆ Junior School
- ◆ Middle School
- ◆ Senior School

Kindergarten (KG1 and KG2)

The kindergarten program provides students with an opportunity to learn basic academic skills in reading, writing, Mathematics and General knowledge. In addition, the students develop social skills through creative activities, projects and music.

Junior School (Grades I-IV)

The Junior School curriculum at Christ Nagar International School exposes the students to wide learning area. They are provided learning through various textbooks, activities and projects related to the subjects offered starting from Grade I. This is to nurture children in all dimensions and also to give an opportunity for the children to find out their area of interest from the young age itself.

The curriculum is provided in the areas of:

- Languages – English, Malayalam, Hindi
- Mathematics
- Science
- Social Studies
- Computer Education
- Art Education – Visual Art (Drawing/Painting), Performing Art (Dance & Music)
- Physical Education
- Moral and Ethical Education
- General Awareness

English, Mathematics and Science curriculum are propounded around the Cambridge Primary Curriculum.

Middle School (Grades V-VIII)

The Middle School curriculum (Cambridge Lower Secondary) is typically for learners aged 10 to 13 years. At Christ Nagar International School, we help children prepare for the next step of their education by providing a clear path as they progress through the Cambridge Pathway in an age-appropriate way.

The Cambridge lower secondary curriculum at CNIS prepares the students for IGCSE Exams. Children take Checkpoint tests at the end of Grade VIII. The exams are evaluated by CAIE and it provides an external international benchmark for your child's performance. In addition to the subjects offered in the Junior School curriculum, the Middle School curriculum offers Foreign language (French/German) from Grade VI.

Senior School (Grades IX-XII)

The Senior School curriculum comprises of Cambridge IGCSE and AS & A Levels.

Cambridge IGCSE is a two year programme spreading across Grades IX and X leading to externally set, marked and certificated examinations from the University of Cambridge at the end of the second year. Cambridge IGCSE is the world's most popular international qualification for 14 to 16 year olds, although it can be taken by students of other ages. AS & A Levels are done in Grades XI & XII respectively.

ICE Awards

Cambridge ICE is a group award for Cambridge IGCSE and it allows schools to offer a broad and balanced curriculum by recognising the achievements of learners who pass examinations in at least seven Cambridge IGCSE subjects from five different subject groups, including two different languages.

To be specific, ICE award is given to children who appear and clear a minimum of seven subjects in the IGCSE exams.

English, French/German, Mathematics are compulsory subjects.

Optional Subjects offered at CNIS in IGCSE

- Individual Sciences / Coordinated Sciences/ Combined Sciences
- Geography / Sociology/ Environmental Management / History
- ICT/ Art & Design

Cambridge International AS & A Levels are international in outlook, but retain a native relevance. The syllabuses provide opportunities for contextualised learning and the content has been created to suit a wide variety of schools, avoid cultural bias and develop essential lifelong skills, including creative thinking and problem solving.

Options at CNIS for AS and A Levels

Possible combinations of subjects:

Option PCMB: English, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Biology

Option PCMC: English, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Computer Science

Option PCBP: English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Psychology.
