Rules for Extempore

- The speaker should take care to select appropriate words for public speaking.
- The purpose of the extempore speech is not only to test the knowledge on a given topic, but also to test the ability to communicate in the presence of an audience.
- All contestants will speak on the same topic and will be given only 5 minutes to prepare.
- They are not allowed to seek any outside help.
- The speaker is allowed to make notes only on the given piece of paper with the topic written on it.
- The contestant is not allowed to read out the speech.
- There will be a warning bell after 4 minutes and a final bell at the end of the 5th minute.
